MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MEETING ON 9th MARCH 2020

Ings Lane Court Order (Min 20/52)

The District Council have agreed to investigate installing a locked gate on Ings Lane and to liaise with the County Council on ensuring pedestrian and horse riding access.

Lorries in Kirkby Lane (Min 20/53)

Quorn have acknowledged receipt but a detailed response is awaited.

Litter Bins (Min 20/54)

The roads on Waters Meet are still unadopted and the Developer is therefore responsible for litter bin provision at the present time. The District Council are looking at the need for litter bins on the High Street at the southern end.

Grass and Hedge Cutting Contract 2020/21 (Min 20/56))

The Contractor's operatives will wear hi-viz jackets.

Damaged footway and wall at the Water Splash (Min 20/60)

The County Council have repaired the wall and have ordered new posts for the fence.
