Notices had been put up in the village and stencil messages had been put on the Holme and footpaths reminding dog owners to pick up faeces. More notices are to be put up and there appeared to have been an improvement in the situation.

The contract for phase one of the refurbishment had been forwarded to AB Playgrounds for signing with a start date for the work of the 14th May. The Playground would be closed for two weeks whilst the work was being carried out. Notices would be posted at the playground and on the local Facebook site.

The District Council were being recommended to approve a grant of £6,320 for the second phase of the refurbishment. Councillor Jones would liaise with the County Council on the access from the public highway for the new track.
