MINUTES

21/68 PRESENT Councillors Geoff Ablett, David Ashton, Helen Eldabe, Robert Jones, David Moreton, Michael O'Neill (Chair) and Susan Wilmot.

21/69 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE: District Councillor Andy Wake.

21/70 ALSO PRESENT: County Councillor Heather Moorhouse and District Councillor Bryn Griffiths.

21/71. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: No interests were declared.

21/72. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on the 12th April 2021 were approved and will be signed by the Chair as a true record.

21/73 POLICE REPORT

The report covering the period from the 11th April 2021 to the 3rd May 2021, was noted. It mentioned three incidents- a skip fire, a theft and a drug related crime.

RESOLVED That representations be made to the Police to request that these reports be presented with further information on incidents as the current reports are totally inadequate.

21/74 RATS

The District Council's Pest Control Officer had visited but had found no evidence that the problem was beck based. He had asked for further information on sightings.

RESOLVED That a local Facebook survey be carried out asking for details of specific sighting of rats in the village.

21/75 PLAYGROUND REFURBISHMENT

The District Council had agreed to make a grant of £6,320 under their "Make a Difference" Scheme for an accessible basket swing with appropriate access.

Kirkby Parish Council had agreed to make a grant of £2,500 to provide an additional piece of equipment during the refurbishment.

The contracts for the refurbishment by AB Playgrounds had been executed with a start date for the work of the 10th May. The Playground would be closed for two weeks whilst the work was being carried out. Notices would be posted at the playground and on the local Facebook site.

RESOLVED That Councillors O'Neill and Jones negotiate to provide further improved access from the road to the playground within the budget provision for the refurbishment.
